COURSE OF FIRE:

| Unlimited Sighters | Prone or supported (with rest) | 10 minutes |
| Stage 1 | 10 shots Prone slow fire | 10 minutes |
| Stage 2 | 10 shots Prone rapid fire in 2 series of 5 in | 25 sec.semi-auto/30sec.manual |
| Stage 3 | 10 shots Sitting or Kneel slow fire | 10 minutes |
| Stage 4 | 10 shots Sitting or Kneel rf in 2 series of 5 in | 25 sec.semi-auto/30sec.manual |
| Stage 5 | 10 shots Standing slow fire | 10 minutes |
| Stage 6 | 10 shots Standing rapid fire in 2 series of 5 in | 25 sec.semi-auto/30sec.manual |

Stages 2 and 4 start from standing and get into position after the "start" command (exception for seniors & handicapped).

EQUIPMENT

Any standard sporter-type rifle chambered for .22 Long Rifle of conventional appearance may be used.

- Must be capable of loading and firing 5 shot rapid fire strings
- Must not weigh more than 7.5 lbs including sights but not slings
- Standard sporter type stock without any adjustments or attachments other than sling swivels.
- Must have at least 3 lb trigger pull.
- Sights will be either: O-class (open sights) or T-Class (Target Aperture or Telescopic up to 6 power)

No more than 2 layers of sport /casual clothing (no padded shooting coats or gloves)

May use shooting matt, kneeling roll, and spotting scope or binoculars. (available at the club)

Ear and eye protection is required (available at the club)

Empty chamber indicators must be inserted when not prepping or shooting. (available at the club)

CLASSES *Competitors may shoot more than 1 class*
