This will be an NRA 4-Position conventional Smallbore rifle match fired from 50 feet on the A-17 target. The latest published NRA Rules will govern. Positions per NRA rule 5.6 (prone), 5.8 (sitting), 5.10 (kneeling), and 5.12 (standing). Any rifle per rule 3.2, any sights per Rule 3.7.

Location: The **Winnequah Gun Club Indoor Range** approximately 3 miles north of Lodi, WI at the northern intersection of Cty hwys J and V near Harmony Grove(not the old entrance on Lange Rd!).

MATCH 6: FOUR-PERSON TEAM MATCH

The scores of Match 5 will be used to determine the award winners. There must be two teams for an award to be given. Class awards will be given to the high class A (Master/Expert) team and the high class B (Sharpshooter/Marksman) team and the high junior team if there are at least 3 teams in a class. Team members must be declared prior to shooting.

CLASSIFICATION

Competitors will be classified according to the NRA classification system. The shooter's current NRA indoor conventional position classification will be used or an assigned classification will be accepted. Shooters with no classification will fire as masters.

AWARDS

Cash awards will be presented to the winner of each match and to the high shooter in each class of at least 5 competitors. Classes with less than five competitors will be combined with the next higher class to reach a 5-competitor minimum. Category awards may be given in match 5. Possible categories include Ladies, Juniors, Seniors, Iron-sight shooters. There must be at least 3 shooters in a category for an award to be given.
