**Directions:** Winnequah Gun Club range is located approximately three miles north of Lodi, WI. Take I90/94 to the LODI-ARLINGTON turnoff (Exit 119) about 25 miles north of Madison and turn west on WI HWY 60 toward Lodi (3 miles). Just before Lodi, turn north (right) on Lindsay Rd. and proceed to CTY HWY J (0.7 miles). Continue on J and V approximately one mile. Continue on CTY HWY V approximately ¼ mile to the new Indoor Range building on the left. Go through the gate and past the building. Follow the new road to the High Power Rifle Stat Office. Signs will be posted. Distance from Interstate Highway is approximately four miles.

**Ammo:** Bring approximately 80 rounds (this should cover both days)
