Will you hunt big game this fall? If yes, you cannot miss the Winnequah Gun Club's *Big Game Shooting Clinic*.

This shooting clinic is designed to develop your confidence in both your equipment and yourself when taking long range shots at big game from 200 to 500 yards. During this clinic, you will first verify your rifle zeros by shooting from a bench rest at 200 yards. Then you will shoot standing, sitting, and prone at 200, 300, 400, and 500 yards at both bulls-eye and game silhouette targets. You will join other shooters along with experienced hunters and shooters serving as your coaches for the day. This experience will help you to learn when to and when not to take that shot at a trophy elk, deer, antelope, moose or other big game animal.

With all the cost and planning you will invest in a big game hunt, take advantage of this opportunity to hone your long distance shooting capabilities by participating in this clinic. Share tips and learn from others as you spend the day getting comfortable with your gear and training your eye to judge distance. In addition, we will feed you lunch!
