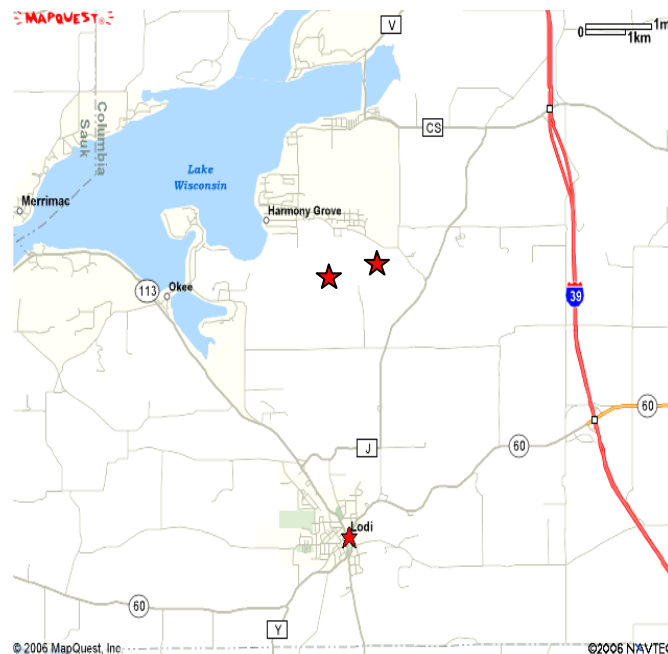

## Smallbore and Air Rifle Marksmanship Program



**Weekly Training and practice** sessions under the guidance of experienced coaches. The club provides all guns, ammo and equipment needed for participation.

Members participate in The **NRA Smallbore or air rifle qualification programs:**

**EXPERT:** 14 stages of achievement with medals and certificates at each stage. Progressively more difficult qualification scores to reach the top level of expert.

**DISTINGUISHED EXPERT:** 10 Qualifying targets in each position (Prone, Sitting, Kneeling, and Standing). Requires advanced skills and consistency to complete. Receive recognition in NRA Insights Magazine.

**Individual and team competition** in Junior and open matches around the state gives members opportunities to test their skills and receive national ranking and recognition.



## High Power Marksmanship Program



**Training and participation in National Match Course competition**, involving shooting slow fire and rapid fire at 200, 300 and 600 yds from prone, sitting, and standing positions. The club has .223 rifles in both semi-automatic and bolt action for use by the junior shooters as well as all the other equipment needed. Members train and practice weekly at the club high power league along with adult members in a simulated match format.

Participants can shoot in matches at our home range and several matches around the state as well as the National Championships at Camp Perry, Ohio.
