SMALLBORE/AIR RIFLE PROGRAM

Greetings, Young Shooting Sports Enthusiasts! Are you are interested in learning rifle shooting skills? Winnequah Jr Rifle Club can help:

We will be starting our **WINNEQUAH JUNIOR SMALL BORE(.22) RIFLE and AIR RIFLE PROGRAMS** on Mon, Oct 3rd from 6:00 to 9:00pm. The first night will be primarily for equipment checking and organization. It will continue **Every Monday** through March, except for holiday breaks Nov 22nd and Dec 26th. You may join at any time during the season and participate as often as your schedule permits.

The program is at the Winnequah Gun Club Indoor Range and Training Facility! It is located at the northern intersection of J and V near Harmony Grove, North of Lodi. We welcome shooters from the surrounding areas of northern Dane and southern Columbia Counties.

This Program of rifle marksmanship skill development is for boys and girls of all ages with no previous experience necessary and consists of:

- 22 evenings of instruction and practice in Olympic style shooting using .22 cal Target Rifles or Air Rifles Supervised by NRA certified Instructors and other experienced coaches.
- Participation in the NRA Jr. Qualification Program with Awards and medals at each level of achievement. Most members take 2 to 3 seasons to complete 140 qualifying targets to reach the **'EXPERT'** level but it is possible to do it in little more than 1 season. There is also a **'DISTINGUISHED EXPERT'** badge beyond that and we have several current members who have achieved that status.
- Opportunities for competition in 5 or more sectional and State Matches, as well as club matches.
- Information regarding High Power Rifle competition and other shooting sports opportunities.

Winnequah Gun Club Provides Air Rifles and .22 cal target rifles, spotting scopes, shooting coats, mats, gloves, etc. and assistance with ammo. They also provide liability insurance and NRA, USA shooting, and CMP affiliation.

A Parent or guardian must be present to register shooters and will be welcome to help with weekly assistance in running the club programs (scoring targets, coaching, etc).

(At registration we will need the youth's Address, DOB, Phone, health information and NRA No for our records]

The costs for the programs are as follows:

.22 Cal Target Rifle Program:

- Annual Club Dues** **\$35** Due by 10/24 or 4 weeks after joining the club, Covers awards, targets, and other supplies. It will also include a club T-shirt. Dues will be prorated for members starting mid season.
- Newcomers Tryout** **\$15** due the first night. We will provide 2 introductory sessions including all equipment and ammo and personalized instruction. This fee will be applied to your club dues if you decide to join.
- Rifle and Ammo usage fees** **\$6.00 per 100** rounds includes target velocity .22LR (about \$3.00/wk), a club target rifle, coat, glove and other equipment. Total about \$40-\$60 (depending on your level of participation) for practice and Qualification for the year. (Pd week by week as ammo is issued)
- Match Fees (optional)** The member will be responsible for Individual match fees (usually about \$10-15 per match). The club will pay the Team fees and provides ammo for the USA Shooting match, the NRA JR sectional Matches (2), and the NRA JR State Championships (2). **Total-About \$60-\$70** for 5 Supported Matches per year

Air Rifle Program:

- Annual Club Dues** **\$20** Due by 10/24 or 4 weeks after joining the club, Covers awards, targets, and other supplies. It will also include a club T-shirt. Dues will be prorated for members starting mid season.
- Newcomer Tryout** **\$8** due the first night. We will provide 2 introductory sessions including all equipment and ammo and personalized instruction. This fee will be applied to your club dues if you decide to join.
- Rifle and Ammo usage fees** \$2.00 per 100 rounds includes pellets (about \$1.00/wk), a club rifle, coat, glove and other equipment. (Pd week by week as ammo is issued)
- Match Fees (optional)** The member will be responsible for Individual match fees (usually about \$10-15 per match). The club will pay the Team fees and provides ammo For 2or 3 Supported Matches per year. **Total-About \$30-\$35.**
- NRA JR Membership (optional)** **\$15** Includes NRA Insights magazine for Juniors and is needed for some matches.

(Additional Club T-shirts (\$10) and sweatshirts (\$15) will be available!)
